

Eight Things Your School Can Do To Maximize The Amount Of Funding Your School Receives From Peace Maker Foundation

1. Send an email to parents and friends of your school with a short message about how contributions to Peace Maker Foundation will be doubled and returned to your school. The email can include a link to the Peace Maker Foundation website for making an on-line contribution. A template email message is available from the Foundation.
2. Encourage a parent who is supportive of your efforts to send out a letter or email to his or her friends informing them that for every \$1 contributed, your school will receive \$2. A template available from the Foundation.
3. At a school event put out Peace Maker Foundation raffle tickets or gift envelopes with a note that for every dollar contributed your school will receive \$2.
4. If your school is connected to a faith community, put a notice in the congregation's bulletin or ask that money usually collected for doughnuts or some other special occasion be used to generate 2:1 matching money for your school.
5. Request that your PTA or your school district's foundation make a gift to Peace Maker Foundation for your work. The amount contributed will be matched 2:1.
6. Make an appeal to a civic organization like the Rotary, Lions, Knights of Columbus, etc. Let them know that their support for your work will be matched 2:1.
7. Inform your co-workers that United Way gifts designated to Peace Maker Foundation in Roseville will be matched 2:1.
8. Start a petition among your co-workers to make Peace Maker Foundation a charitable giving option for employees at your school or within your district. Peace Maker Foundation will match these gifts 3:1. A template petition form is available from the Foundation.
