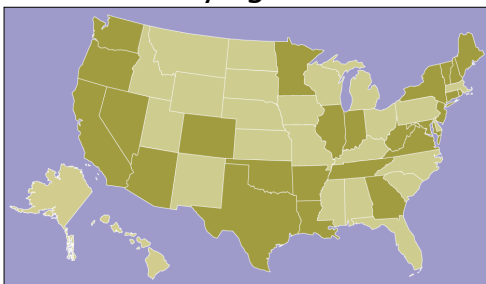

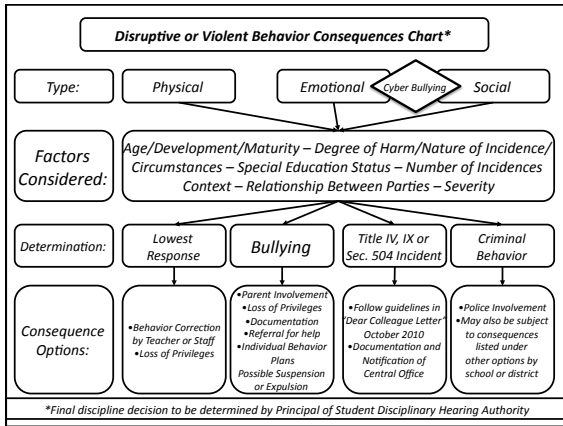
Most State Laws Require Schools to have an Anti-Bullying Policy
