RESPONSIBILITIES

The Educational Advisory Committee is comprised of one representative from each MESPA division, and a chairperson appointed by the MESPA president. Committee members are requested to attend the Leadership Conference and to help facilitate Institute sessions. The committee chair also attends all Board of Directors meetings in September, December, February, and May.

The responsibilities of this committee are to review principals' current and long-range education needs based upon the changing role of the principalship:

- serve as advisors for program planning for the MESPA Institute
- recommend topics for professional development seminars, workshops or new programs
- facilitate MESPA relationships with higher education institutions, other professional associations and organizations throughout Minnesota
- serve as monitors, finding answers for questions posted on the MESPA Web site
- introduce speakers and help facilitate Institute focus sessions
- report to the Board of Directors as requested.
