

MESPA MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Active Dues \$636.00
A licensed principal employed as an elementary principal, middle level principal, assistant principal or principal on special assignment shall be an Active member. An Active member shall have the right to vote and hold office.

Other Administrator..... Dues \$484.00
A licensed school administrator other than someone eligible for Active membership.

Intern Principal..... Dues \$163.00
Educators interested in entering the profession, involved in an administration preparatory program, serving as an intern under direct supervision of a principal.

Associate (includes Working Retired principals)..... Dues \$163.00
A licensed, non-practicing administrator or post secondary educator or a retired principal who is currently working in education, *but outside of an active principalship*.

Retired Principal Dues \$40.00
A retired principal who was an Active member at the time of retirement who is no longer working in education. *A retired principal working as an Interim principal must join in the Active category for legal benefits.*

25 Year Club Dues \$10.00
MESPA members with 25 years in education, serving 10 or more as an elementary or middle level principal.

Aspiring Principal Dues \$59.00
Educators interested in entering the profession or involved in a recognized administration program.

Unrequested Leave Dues \$163.00
An Active member placed on unrequested leave.

NAESP MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Active Dues \$235.00
Available to on-line principals, assistant principals, and others employed in professional work related to the elementary and middle school principalship.

Institutional-Active Dues \$280.00
Includes an Active membership and a duplicate set of member publications for the institution.

Associate Dues \$135.00
Available to professors of education or non-administrators interested in elementary or middle school administration.

International Associate Dues \$165.00
Available to principals or school heads employed outside the United States.

Aspiring Principal Dues \$80.00
Available to teachers and students pursuing a career in the principalship.

Emeritus Dues \$118.00
Available to all retired NAESP Active members; includes all NAESP programs and services, plus AARP membership.

Retired Dues \$60.00
Available to all retired NAESP Active members, or current Emeritus members; includes some NAESP benefits and services.

Institutional Subscription Dues \$150.00
Available to libraries, including subscription to NAESP publications.
