MSS Bullying Analysis, 2010



- Students regularly involved in bullying as a bully, victim or bully/victim
- Share associated experiences, most of them negative.
 - Harassment, physical assault in school
 - Intra-familial and extra-familial sexual abuse
 - Family drug use and family violence

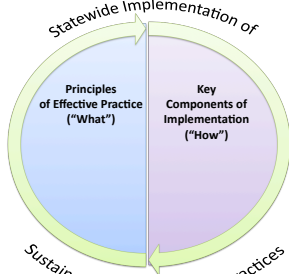

TRAINING COMPONENTS	OUTCOMES (% of Participants who Demonstrate Knowledge, Demonstrate new Skills in a Training Setting, and Use new Skills in the Classroom)		
	Knowledge	Skill Demonstration	Use in the Classroom
Theory and Discussion	10%	5%	0%
...+Demonstration in Training	30%	20%	0%
...+ Practice & Feedback in Training	60%	60%	5%
...+ Coaching in Classroom	95%	95%	95%
